I met Louise this past summer when Joe Pabst directed us in Over the River and Through the Woods at Henrico Theatre Company. I'd intend to suggest you keep an eye open for Louise so you could grab her up next spring when she graduates from Shenandoah University.

Louise is a spunky creature both on and off stage. With the look of an ingenue and the flexibility of a character actor, she can easily pull off whatever roles you cast her in; however, the reason I think she would be an terrific touring actor is because of her personality. She is always even-tempered, good-natured and downright fun. She never brought negativity into our dressing room and she presents herself in a direct non-confrontational manner.

Louise has experience with children having worked under Amy Perdue in many theatre camps, including the variety of age-groups Louise over-saw and directed in the summer camps during our rehearsal and performance period. If I am not mistaken, Louise also studied children's theatre and children's theatre education at Shenandoah.

I would have relished an actor like Louise in my Theatre IV touring days. Outside of the requisite talent necessary for Theatre IV artistry, Louise has the temperament that would help her fit into any cast.
